

**Students should choose a level of homework where they are challenged but not frustrated. Picking a homework which is too easy will reflect a lower score. Picking a homework that is too challenging will also reflect a lower score!**

**Some students may be challenged by a mild level of homework, and that is OK!**

### MILD

This homework has sentence starters. Choose this homework if you have an idea about the word, but are not sure you know how to use the words correctly. With effort, the most likely grade is less than a 6.

### MEDIUM

This homework asks you to use all of the words in sentences. They should be used as the correct part of speech and include details to show you understand the meaning. For example for the MYP word “reflective” I would expect a sentence like, “After I got my paper back, I needed to be reflective and think about what I did well and what I would like to do differently.” With effort, the most likely grade is a 6.

### PICANTE

To “spice” up your writing, you need to connect your sentences together to tell a story! You might need to add other sentences to make the story make sense. It may even involve adding an extra sheet of paper. This is taking your writing “Above and Beyond!” With effort, the most likely grade is as high as an 8. However, if you don’t put in the thought and effort, or if your skills aren’t quite ready for the challenge, it will be more obvious and the score will reflect it.
